Activities

Day 1:

Familiarization phase: (Warm-up period)

Welcome song:

Say hello to each other and ask them about the weather. How's the weather today? Is it sunny? Is it cloudy? Is it rainy? Or is it windy?

Input phase:

Print out the ABC Letter Cards(attached below) or write your own letters on post-it notes.

- **Note:** Print them back to back so that each letter card has the answer on the back. Or choose only to print the big letter cards (so you'd print every other page). It's up to you!

These letter cards go along perfectly with Jack Hartmann's song "**Learning Letter Sounds Version 2**" from YouTube:

Play the song and have you kids sing along while you show them the letter cards.

Game:

Hide the letters around your house, and have your little one find them. Once they find a letter, ask them to tell you the name of the letter, sound of the letter, and a word that starts with that letter.

Day 2:

Familiarization phase: (Warm-up period)

Say hello to each other and ask them "How are you?" "Fine?" Then ask about the weather. How's the weather today? Is it sunny? Is it cloudy? Is it rainy? Or is it windy?

Input phase:

Draw hearts on a piece of paper, and then write letters inside the hearts. Have your little one find and color each letter that you call out. You could call out the name, sound, or a word that starts with the letter. Your little one could use markers, crayons, or do-a-dot markers to color in the heart.

Say hello to each other and ask them "How are you?" "Great?" Then ask about the weather. How's the weather today? Is it sunny? Is it cloudy? Is it rainy? Or is it windy?

Input phase:

Use the Name & Letter sort attached below to sort letters in a variety of ways. You can choose to print out the letters in the printable, or you can use letters you already have (like refrigerator letters). Choose which ways to have your little one sort the letters (there are 4 mats to choose from).

Say hello to each other and ask them "How are you?" "Well?" Then ask about the weather. How's the weather today? Is it cloudy? Is it sunny? Is it windy? Or is it rainy?

Input phase:

Choose a story to read aloud to your little one, but don't show them the pictures. Instead, have them draw a picture while you're reading of what they're imagining in their minds. Then show them the pictures and compare their drawings with the book's drawings.
